



Robertson Winery & Gaborone Yacht Club 05th August 2017

Competition Rules:

1. Minimum 1 person Maximum 4 people per team
2. Cooking can be done on Coal or Gas (GYC will provide "central" fire for coals)
3. Any size 3-leg potjie can be used
4. All preparations must take place on the premises
5. Participants to kindly supply all their own utensils and other equipment
6. It is compulsory to use a bottle of ROBERTSON Wine, that will be provided, in your potjie. There will be a choice of: Red, White and Rosé.
7. Potjie to be cooked with accompaniments (pap, rice etc), to be prepared on the premises
8. One team member must be at the stand at all times
9. Teams must start promptly at 10h00, maximum 4 hours cooking time allowed
10. Judging will take place from 14h00 - 1500
11. Each team to provide a "taster" for 3 judges, place setting to be provided for 1 judge at a time to sit and taste
12. Prize giving will be at 16h00, the judges' decision is final
13. There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd Prize
14. Prizes are:
 - 1st P2000 plus 2 Cases of any Robertson 12 x 750ml Wine
 - 2nd P1000 plus 2 Cases of any Robertson Wine
 - 3rd P500 plus 1 Case of any Robertson Wine
15. What is left of the food is for the team's family and friends to enjoy
16. Participants must use the P300 Butcher Shop voucher supplied. Proof of use of this voucher will be requested on the day of the competition.

General Information:

1. Team members of each team will not need to pay the Entry Fee to get into the Yacht Club, but anyone else attending with them will have to pay.
2. Entry Fee for spectators is P30 per person, P10 per GYC member & kids under 12 Free.
3. There will be a Jumping Castle for the kids. There will also be Popcorn and Candyfloss on sale.
4. **NO** beverages may be brought onto the Gaborone Yacht Club premises, all beverages must be bought from the Gaborone Yacht Club bar. A fine of P500 will be charged to anyone caught with their own beverages on the premises.
5. **NO** food except for the ingredients for the competition meal may be brought onto the Gaborone Yacht Club premises.
6. There will be a bar serving beverages & food for sale in the competition area.
